

Exam Expectations

- Make every effort to get to your warm up on time. These will really help you to get in the right mindset for your exam
- Please assemble in the hall after your morning warm up. You will be told when to go into the gym from there
- If you have an afternoon exam you go straight to the bag store then into the gym. You need to do this 5 minutes before the start time. If you are out on the field, be really careful to come in in plenty of time – don't wait for the bell
- You shouldn't leave the exam to go to the toilet unless it is absolutely unavoidable. Go before the exam starts. Every minute of your exam counts
- All students in all year groups are expected to stick to the silences/ no entry signs and be silent in areas around the gym and the other exam rooms. Please don't start talking to your friends as you leave the gym as many students will still be using their additional time and will need silence to concentrate



Collapsed Timetable

- This has been created to give you as much time with your subject teacher as possible at times that will be beneficial to your exam preparation
- Always follow your normal timetable unless there are changes shown
- P5 follows the normal rota unless there are changes shown
- At times, only students doing a particular subject will be asked to stay e.g 14th May all historians stay for P5. Students who don't do history may go home at 3.15. This is because there is a history exam on the morning of the 15th
- The evidence shows this is a more effective use of Year 11 time. Almost all schools now do this in the lead up to exams
- Student voice from your year group has requested this to avoid feeling like time is being wasted
- Remember, no timetable changes will suit everyone – please keep turning up with the positive approach and mature behaviour that we have seen so far from you as a Year group. We are already very proud of you, but the most important part is yet to come

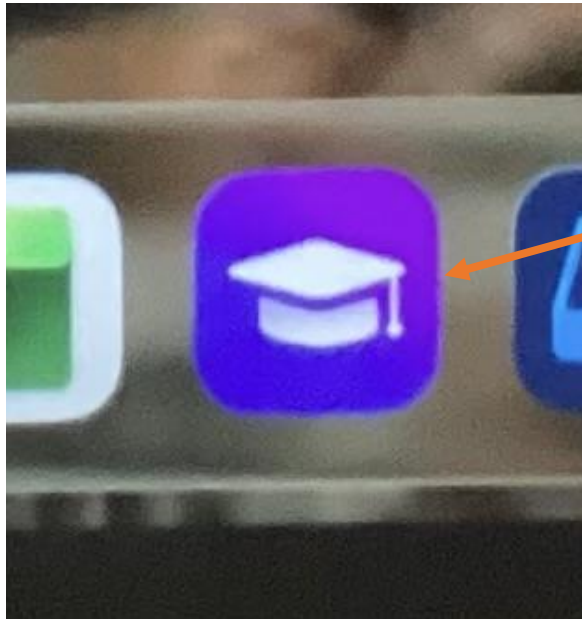
