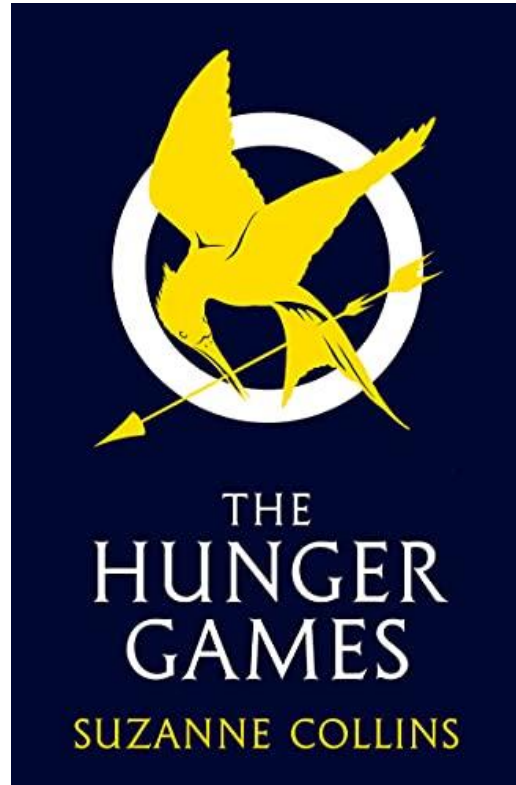








The Hunger Games

Suzanne Collins (b 1962)

- **Suzanne Collins** was born August 10, 1962 and is an American author and television writer. Collins graduated from the Alabama School of Fine Arts in Birmingham in 1980 as a Theater Arts major. She began her career in 1991 as a writer for children's television shows.^[8] She worked on several shows for Nickelodeon.
- **She said** 'I have two older sisters and one older brother and hold them largely responsible for the trouble I got into growing up. I believe as the youngest child, that is my right.'
- **Did you know?** A film version of The Hunger Games grossed just under \$700 million globally.
