To Students, Parents and Carers:

St Ives School places a very high value on developing our students' moral, cultural and social understanding and the wider education of children 'beyond the classroom'.

The aim of the Year 8 and 9 Be Inspired Week is that all students take part in activities which contribute to personal development and interest in a number of ways. We want you to try things that challenge you and we feel that the activities offered will do just that. The activities and how they will be arranged are described in the next few pages.

All programmes on offer will be both enjoyable and challenging: we hope that you will take part in the right spirit and gain from them. All activities are suitable for beginners and we challenge you to take this opportunity to try something that is new to you. There is a range of activities that vary in cost from free options to higher cost adventurous activities (which can be paid over time). If you need more information about a particular activity then please speak to the relevant member of staff to see if it will interest you.

When you have read this booklet with your parents, decide which programme you want to take part in and then complete the Google Form. You will need to name 3 different options as most activities have limited numbers. Following on from making your choices, we will let you know which activity has been allocated to you and then set up your payment details on the School Gateway app.

All deposits (10%) for the different activities will need to be paid by **Friday 10th March** but balances can be paid in instalments over the next few months so you so you do not have to pay for it all in one go. If you are in receipt of financial support from the government or if you are experiencing any difficulties in meeting the cost of Be Inspired Week for your child then please email Mr Olds and we will be in touch. All emails will be dealt with in the strictest of confidence.

Then this is the week for you!

Day trips will depart from school each day at 9am to various places in Cornwall.

Kernow Week


This week students will be travelling around Cornwall to a variety of venues. These will all have a cultural or environmental theme. We will be going to the following places:

Coach travel and entry fees are all included.



sailing or Windsurfing

Students will participate in one of the two activities: SAILING OR WINDSURFING

RYA Level 1&2 Dinghy Sailing

Learning in a dinghy is a great way to start sailing and the RYA level 1 course is designed for complete beginners, learning how to rig dinghies, sail in all directions and develop awareness of launching and recovery. Students will be issued a training logbook and, on the successful completion of the course, a certificate. If time and conditions allow, they will progress onto the RYA level 2 sailing course. During level 2 you will work on building your confidence and develop your skills sailing around a course tacking, gybing and controlling your boat speed. By the end of this course, you will be a competent sailor in light winds. All equipment is provided; students need swimming costumes, towel, sun cream, hat, water, lunch and wetsuit boots or an old pair of trainers. The centre provides wetsuits and buoyancy aids but you can choose to wear your own.

sailing or Windsurfing

Students will participate in one of the two activities: SAILING OR WINDSURFING

RYA Level 1& 2 Windsurfing

The RYA Windsurfing scheme is an easy and accessible way to get started and progress in this exciting sport. Designed to get kids up and windsurfing over a number of short sessions or two full days, they will be hooked from their first taster and will be blasting across the water in no time. The level 1 qualification is an introduction to the basics of getting on the water and sailing across the wind through fun games and exercises. Students will be issued a training logbook and, on the successful completion of the course, a certificate. If time and conditions allow, they will progress onto the RYA level 2 Windsurfing course. During level 2 you will work on developing the windsurfing skills needed to sail around a course, tacking and gybing. All equipment is provided; students need swimming costumes, towel, sun cream, hat, water, lunch and wetsuit.
