Our outstanding SEND provision ensures that every child is given the support they need to access the level of reading required at secondary school: in Years 7 and 8 we also provide bespoke 1:1 and small-group reading development tutorials with specialist teachers, focussing on specific reading and comprehension skills with students whom we've identified as needing more support with these.

St lves School has one of the best school libraries in Cornwall, with over 6000 books in stock for students to borrow. We have a wide range of fiction and non-fiction texts catering for 11-16 year-olds and beyond, so everyone is sure to find something they enjoy for their independent reading or research. Our School Librarian is on hand to help your child choose age-appropriate texts which they will enjoy reading and which will help them think about the world from different perspectives. Each student is allowed to take out up to 3 books at any one time. They are stamped for 3 school weeks, but can be renewed if needed.
