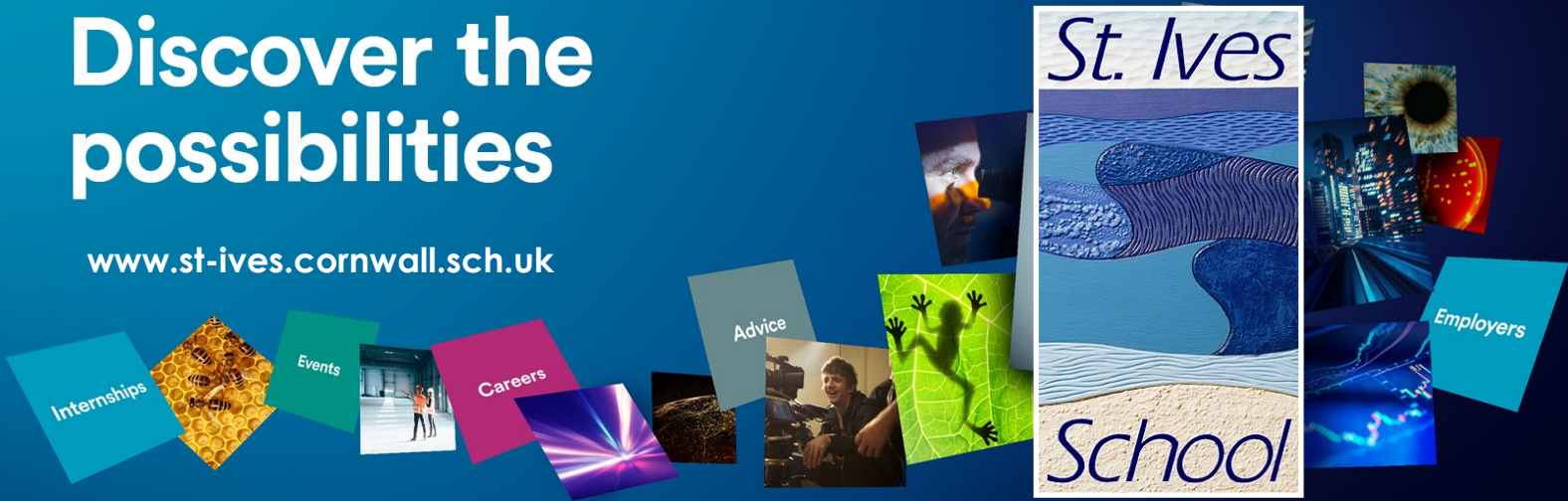

On Friday 10th December all Year 11 students had the opportunity to take part in a Further Education Careers Fair. Students were really engaged with the sessions and the guests were highly impressed with their questions.

Careers Carousel

On Wednesday 24th November all Year 8 students took part in a Careers Carousel event. There were representative from a wide range of industries and over 24 businesses in total. Students met with at least 8 businesses and questioned them on a range of points about their jobs. Student feedback is very positive and businesses were highly impressed with how polite, well-mannered and through students were with their questioning.



MOCK COLLEGE INTERVIEWS

As part of the student preparations for the next step to college and further education we are holding mock interviews for all year 11 students. The aim is that the interviews will allow students a chance to develop confidence prior to their college interviews.

These interviews will take place after school on 12th January from 3.30pm-5pm. A range of employers will conduct interviews. Students will have prepared for these interviews in their PSHE lessons and will be made aware of their time and location for interview.

Tutor rooms will be open during the session to allow students a space to prepare for their interviews in advance. Students may also leave school and come back if their interview is later in the afternoon.

APPLICATION SUPPORT FOR YEAR 11 STUDENTS

As students have started attending Further Education open evenings I thought it would be timely to send across details on how to apply.

To apply to Truro or Penwith College on-line please use this link:

Students will need to use a personal email address for this process and will get emailed and text a code to their mobile number as part of the application process too. They will need to confirm receipt of these things before they can submit their applications. They will also need their parent/carer email address and contact details as well as their 'on track to get' grades' to complete any College or Sixth Form applications. These 'on track to get' details will be available from their tutors.
